**Background** : GGG+Forum was launched in 2016 with its aim to promote Japanese Government's effort to achieve UHC and SDGs. GGG+ Forum 2018 in Kenya was co-hosted by RESULTS Japan and the Kenyan Government in July, 2018. There were 240 participants including Sicily Kariuki, Cabinet Secretary, Ministry of Health, Kenya and key figures in global health organizations such as Global Fund, Gavi, GHIT Fund, WHO and UNICEF. It was confirmed that the cooperation between participants will be strengthened and interventions will be made to progress in global health section. Governments of Japan and African countries, academia, private sector, civil society and other players will have specific discussions on global health to gain momentum for achieving UHC and SDGs towards TICAD 7 in August, 2019.
